Mr. Mantz explained that he would like to take the old home on his property out and replace it with a newer, bigger home, and he cannot meet the setbacks needed. Town Attorney asked if it would be a single-family dwelling, Mr. Mantz answered yes, the home currently on there is non-conforming now. Town Attorney asked if the zoning district was HMU, Mr. Mantz answered yes. Town Attorney acknowledged that this is a pre-existing non-conforming lot and it is the practice that the Board to approve all non-conformities that Board and grant variances for them. Also, the Board has in the past stated that a 40% variance is substantial. Town Attorney went through the variances needed:

- Lot Area-(pre-existing) required is 1 acre, proposed is 0.26 acres; a variance of 0.74 acres or 74% is needed
- Lot Width-(pre-existing) required is 200ft, proposed is 50.1±ft; a variance of 149.9±ft or 75±% is needed
- Front Yard Setback-required is 35ft, proposed is 30.5±ft; a variance of 4.5±ft or 13±% is needed
- Side Yard Setback-required is 35ft, proposed is 8±ft; a variance of 27±ft or 77.14±% is needed

Town Attorney then asked what are on the neighbors lots, Mr. Mantz answered single family homes, Town Attorney stated that there is no neighbors objecting, the difficulty is self-created, he plans to put a larger home, he asked if the benefit to Mr. Mantz outweighs the detriment to the Health, Safety or Welfare of the community, Mr. Mantz answered yes. Town Attorney asked if this will be an undesirable change, Mr. Mantz answered no he felt he was improving the lot. Town Attorney asked if he could achieve the proposed without the variance and if there was any other way to place the home without the variance, Mr. Mantz answered no. Town Attorney asked if this is the minimum possible variance, Mr. Mantz answered Yes.
