Local Law #1 of 1999 Establishing Regulations for Numbering of Buildings and Property in the Town of Deerpark

Section 5. Duty of building owners: It shall be the duty of every owner and/or every occupant/tenant of a building in the town of Deerpark to cause to be displayed the street number of said building on a building, post, or other structure at or within 20 feet of the edge of the road surface. The post must be stationed on the same side of the street as the building or premises for which the number is intended.

Section 6. Size and display of numbers:

- **A.** *Residential properties (noncommercial):* The numbers are to be reflective and at least four inches in height and shall be placed on the front of building or on a post of at least four (4) feet in height and not exceeding 10 feet in height so as to be plainly legible and visible from the center of the street. At no times will said numbers be placed on any door. The color of the figures shall be in sharp contrast to the background color. The front of the building shall be understood to be the side which faces the street.
- **B.** *Commercial properties (nonresidential):* The same credentials apply, except that the numbers shall be at least six (6) inches in height.
- **C.** In all cases, the numbers shall be placed so that they may be seen from either direction while driving on the road and shall not be obstructed by trees, shrubbery, porches or other extensions of the building, or snow piles.
- **D.** Wherever practicable, the numbers shall be placed near some light or source of illumination so that they may be readily seen at night.
- **E.** Where the front of the building is more than 20 feet from the edge of the street, the number shall **also** be displayed on a post, mailbox or other structure visible from the street and stationed on the same side of the street as the premises for which it is intended.
- **F.** In the event that more than one house has access from a single driveway, the street number of the house must be displayed at each location at which the driveway diverges from common access.
