Mr. Fellenzer stated that he appreciated that the meeting was held. He explained that there are new buildings and they plan on maintaining the existing currently approved uses. The new portion will be a 85 room hotel, restaurants, a costume shop and film studio also a waste water treatment plant (WWTP). There was a threatened and endangered species report, traffic impact study and archaeological study done. They are there to request a public hearing be scheduled. Chair asked Town Engineer to go through comments. Mr. Fusco stated that a Notice of Intent needed to be done, SPEDES permit would be needed for the waste water treatment plant (WWTP) and the OCDOH (Orange County Department of Health) would have to sign off, the OCDPW (Orange County Department of Public Works) and NYSDOT (New York State Department of Transportation) is reviewing the traffic study, SHPO wants an archaeological study done. Town may require a bond for the public improvements, provide geotechnical reports for new buildings, show current landscaping Board may require additional. He also suggested that the SWPPP should be included in the distribution of the GML-239. Willard Schadt asked if an Environmental Impact Statement should be done with this newest buildout. Town Engineer acknowledged that a positive declaration could be done but he believed the Applicant has provided enough informatioA but if the Board chose they can do a DEIS. He continued that most of the information submitted is encompassed in the Draft Impact Statement. Mr. Fusco added that a negative declaration have been given in the past and Fellenzer Engineering has provided enough information but the Board can ask for more or can ask for a positive dee. Mr. Fusco further stated that he is comfortable with the information provided to move forward with the application. Willard Schadt stated he had not received all the studies, Mr. Fusco asked Secretary to redistribute the link to all the Board members. Willard Schadt asked if after the public hearing they decided to do the positive dee they can still do it. Mr. Fusco answered yes. Willard stated that he felt that at the public hearing public comment may trigger further
