PLANNING BOARD MEETING AUGUST 9, 2023 continued -

NEW CENTURY – 517 NEVERSINK DR – SITE PLAN REVIEW – Ryan Fellenzer-Representative for Applicant Zachary Kelson-Attorney for Applicant

Mr. Fellenzer explained since the public hearing the Applicant has been working to answer the public's comments and concerns stated at the hearing and in writing. There was a traffic study done, endangered species done, NYS fish and wildlife study done, SWPPP (Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan) provided, working with DEC (Department of Environmental Conservation) for WWTP (Wastewater Treatment Plant) for a SPDES (State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) permit and awaiting SHPO (State Historic Preservation Office) approval. It will all show there is no significant environmental impact. John Nosek stated the letter from Kelson in regard to deed restrictions will be given to Glen for review. Fusco also received comments from County Planning and stated it should be sent for further review. Mr. Nosek asked if the NYSDOT (New York State Department of Transportation) or OCDPW (Orange County department of Public Works) has done some response to agree with the traffic study. Mr. Fellenzer stated that they have tried to get ahold of them with no answer. Plans show four wells but minimum is two; Mr. Nosek asked if all four are being drilled, Mr. Fellenzer answered that two are existing and two will be new. Mr. Nosek stated that all documents that need to go to OCDOH (Orange County Department of Health) should be provided for the wells. He asked if a SPDES permit was done yet, Mr. Fellenzer acknowledged it was submitted no word yet. Town Attorney suggested to provide all contacts with NYSDOT, OCDPW, SWPPP and SPDES. Mr. Nosek asked about the WWTP, Mr. Fellenzer stated that it is under design, Delaware Engineering is handling that. Town Attorney stated that he had not received the letter from Mr. Kelson and has not had the chance to review that case numbers he has sited in the letter. If there are any deed restrictions the Planning Board cannot uphold them. He continued that the DOT and DEC should have responses before any actions are taken. Mr. Kelson stated that they will supply the names of their contacts. Chair Wagner stated no action will be taken tonight. Town Attorney stated that the Planning Board Secretary is unfortunately not here tonight, and to call her tomorrow and ask to be put on the next meeting. Town Attorney asked if the traffic study was sent to NYSDOT and OCDPW, Mr. Fellenzer answered yes. Mr. Kelson asked if they had answers to both of the two outstanding agencies they should contact the Secretary to be on the next agenda, Town Attorney replied yes.
