LAKE MCALLISTER – BIG POND RD – DAM REMOVAL – PUBLIC HEARING -

Mr. Goll gave a brief description of the application, this dam was used for the old YMCA camp for swimming and recreational purposes in the 60's. It has recently been classified as a hazard and if it were to fail there would be significant property damage down stream. He went on to say that it is too expensive to update the dam so they will be decommissioning it. To do that they will be pumping down the lake and relocating the fish. The timing for this is slated for the Spring on 2027.

Town Attorney acknowledged that the removal of the dam is to prevent a flood if it were to fail. Mr. Goll continued that it will be pumped down 1-2 feet per day to keep the slopes stable and mitigate any impacts down stream. Once the dam is removed vegetation will be restored over time and there will be an increase in habitat, this is just to eliminate a liability on the property.

Public Comment:

Burt Thelander- Mr. Thelander asked if the DEC will be inspecting, Mr. Goll replied yes along with the Town Engineer. Mr. Thelander continued that the DEC inspections are very important and he is happy that the habitat will be restored.

Grace Woodard-Ms. Woodard asked what the dam classification was, Mr. Goll answered class B, which is a significant hazard. Ms. Woodard further asked how there will not be any flooding by removing the dam and if it would go to the Neversink River, Mr. Goll replied yes it will go to the Neversink via Route 209 and computer models show that it will go up a fraction of an inch.

Chair acknowledged that there is no need to hold open for written comment.
