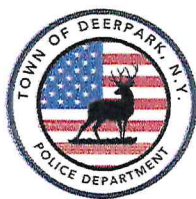

Report for the month of May 2026

May 2026 Monthly Report

For the month, members were called in (4) times for trees down across the roadway.

A general cleanup of Sparrowbush Park was completed. The slide has been repaired finally and another load of mulch was ordered. As soon as it arrives, we will replace the existing mulch and open the playground. As soon as the playground is opened, we will close the swing set area for a day or two for weed control and re-mulch.

Hammering and ditching was completed on Plank Road. We will begin shimming and installing shoulders this month in preparation for chip seal later in the summer.

Hammering and ditch cleaning was also done in a few areas on Prospect Hill Road and Big Pond Road where visibility and drainage was an issue.

We removed rotten guide rail on Plank Road and Franke Road. New rail was installed at those locations as well as on the turn just above dragon springs on Galley Hill Road.

Painted Apron Terrace development was paved with PPST by Gorman/Allstate Construction. We installed shoulders and completed some general repairs in the area.

Mowing is continuing in the parks on a weekly basis.

I attended NYSAOT highway school in Ithaca. This is the annual training provided by speakers from Cornells LTAP center on various topics.

10 of my 11 crew members attended basic first aid, AED, and CPR training at the union hall. Later this year, they will all attend bucket truck certification/re-certification class.

Lastly, I had to close the Shin Hollow Bridge. The steel beams still seem to be structurally sound but the deck has failed again causing washouts to the material in between the beams. This causes sink holes on the roadway surface making it unsafe to travel. I've spoke with Al Fusco regarding a few different options. I am looking at one of the option in another town tomorrow so I will keep the board posted on the process and financial impact as we move forward.
