RESOLUTION 1 - 2021

AGREEMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF HIGHWAY MONEYS

AGREEMENT between the Town Superintendent of the Town of Deerpark,
Orange County, New York, and the undersigned members of the Town Board.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected in the Town for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the State for State Aid for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

1. GENERAL REPAIRS. The sum of \$ 435,000.00 shall be set aside to be expended for primary work and general repairs upon 4.41 miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet and boardwalks or the renewals thereof.

2. PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS. The following sums shall be set aside to be expended for the permanent improvement of town highways:

(a) On the road commencing at Boehmler Rd
and leading to Old Cahoonzie Rd, a distance of 1.86 miles,
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 172,000.00.

Thickness 2 inches

(b) On the road commencing at Old Cahoonzie Rd
and leading to NY State Route 42, a distance of 2.10 miles,
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 194,000.00.
Type Overlay Width of traveled surface 18 feet
Thickness 2 inches

(c) On the road commencing at Nottingham Rd
and leading to Old Cahoonzie Rd, a distance of .18 miles,
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 17,000.00.
Type Overlay Width of traveled surface 18 feet
Thickness 2 inches

(d) On the road commencing at Cahoonzie Club Rd
and leading to Peenpack Trail, a distance of .27 miles,
there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 24,000.00.
Type Overlay Width of traveled surface 16 feet
Thickness 2 inches
