August 2025 Monthly Report

For the month, members were called in (1) time for a tree being down blocking the roadway.

Chip sealing was completed on Port Orange Road, all of Oak Ridge Park, Hoag Road, Wilson Road, the southern portion of Old Forestburg Road, Parks Road, and Rio Damn Road. Fog sealing will take place on those same roads later in the month with the exception of Oak Ridge Park.

We worked with OC parks department to remove a large tree which fell the property line of a resident from Echo Valley Road

We also assisted OCDPW with loading tree debris which they cleaned out of the Neversink River on Shore Drive/Guymard Tpke.

Center line striping took place on Peenpack Trail, Main Street, Berme Road, and Sleepy Hollow Road

For the rest of the month, we've focused on getting Galley Hill Road pave ready. Crossover ditches are being paved, brush is being cut so truck bodies can dump. Ditch work is being completed and shoulder paving is underway. Once shoulders are completed, we will shim the wheel ruts and crossovers and hopefully pave sometime in early October based on the availability of Ward Paving.

I still don't have an official commitment on the SAM grant for the new pick up truck to replace #18 but through correspondence with Senator Skoufis' office, things look positive. Hopefully, I have news at the October meeting.
